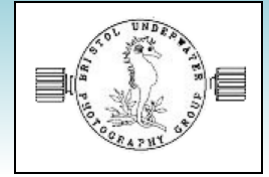


# Bristol Underwater Photography Group

In joint first place was Dan Bolt: Split shot from Babbacombe, making the most of an influx of jellies; egg-laying nudi and amphipod on peacock worm from Scotland; Compass jellyfish and sunburst.





Also in joint first place was Kirsty Andrews: Seal portrait from the Farnes; snouted cup corals; Bib on the Persier

In third place was Cathy Lewis: Gunnel shot with shallow depth of field, Loch Carron; Bass on the Eddystone; nudibranch feeding on tubularia, St Abbs. All taken this year.
