






2025 Splash-in Weekend


WIDE ANGLE

Where is the resort?

Near El Quseir, about halfway between Hurghada and Marsa Alam on the Egyptian Red Sea Coast.

When did you go?

Early June 2025

What facilities were there?

Camp style set up but with proper buildings and A/C, plus on-site dive centre with house reef and guided day trips to other sites

What were the diving highlights?

Unlimited house reef ideal for photography, with many macro and wide angle opportunities. Food excellent with lots of choice even for Veggies!

Anything to think about?

Accommodation is basic, but clean and staff very friendly. 10 minute walk from resort to house reef, so need to carry your camera gear.
